Town Regeneration for Strabane



Problem Identified

Strabane District Council, through its regeneration vehicle Strabane 2000, wanted to give a "new lease of life" to Strabane town centre. They were granted funding towards a regeneration scheme, and planned to create a modern, prestigious environment. The regeneration needed products that were stylish and modern in design, including litter bins and seating.

Solution

Strabane District Council had previously purchased a range of Glasdon products and contacted the company to request a site visit by a specially trained representative. Following discussions a range of Glasdon products were suggested to enhance the town centre.

Stylish and modern in design, with a large 100 litre capacity, Futuro™ litter bins were chosen in millstone colour with silver banding. To address the problem of fire risk, Firexpire®, the unique Glasdon fire safety device was chosen. The Futuro bins also included stainless steel cigarette ash grilles to help control cigarette waste.

The aesthetic, contemporary appearance of Centrum™ stainless steel seating provided the ideal solution for the town centre. Centrum benches are extremely robust and durable, with tamper-resistant stainless steel fixings to reduce the risk of vandalism.

Resulting Benefits

The co-ordinating Glasdon products chosen for the scheme have played a key role in Strabane's street improvements. The Futuro litter bins, complete with cigarette ash grilles and Firexpire have helped reduce the amount of litter in the town centre and the risk of fire in bins. The sleek design of the Centrum stainless steel benches have visually enhanced the appearance of the town centre, and visitors now have the benefit of smart, comfortable seating.

Overall, the regeneration of the town centre has enhanced the "corporate image" of Strabane District Council.
